Ramadhan is a special time for muslims all over the world. A time to strengthen our imaan (faith) and get closer to our Lord. A time to show patience, build brotherhood and increase charity.

We want our children to understand the importance of this Holy month, participate in the prayers and at the same time enjoy the experiences.

This companion is designed to help children make the most of this month.

Younger children may need help from parents or older siblings to achieve tasks based on their age. They may not be able to complete all tasks.

There are 32 cards in the pack.

The 1st card is this instruction card. The 2nd card has Ramadhan duas and a personal goals chart at the back. Write down your personal goals for the month on the 1st day of Ramadhan. A parent or older sibling can help you.

There is one card for each day of the month. The child should take the card for that particular day only.

The companion has different sections. There is a check box that should be ticked once the task in that section is achieved.

1. **Daily dua or hadith.** These are duas that we can use in our daily lives and ahadeeth that are important for us to follow. We encourage older children to memorise them and use them in day to day lives.
2. **Salah chart.** This is a checklist of the 5 daily prayers and Taraweeh.
3. **Quran recitation.** Each child should set their target of how much Quran they will recite on that day.
4. **Deed/activity of the day.** This is an activity or extra ibadah that the child should engage in.
5. **Reflection.** The child should think about how the day went, what they managed to achieve and areas where they need to improve on their behaviour. They should write this down.
6. **A fun activity or story** is at the back of each card.
