

The hunter was astonished by their cooperation and coordination when he saw all the birds flying together with the net. He decided to follow them to see what was going to happen.


A man, whom he met on his way, asked him where he was rushing to. Pointing the birds in the sky, the hunter said he was going to catch the birds.

The man laughed and said: "May God grant you some sense! Do you really think you can catch birds on the wing?"




The spectators were astonished. They asked the slave why the lion had not attacked him.

"God shows his mercy to those who are merciful. Have compassion to creatures on earth so that those in heaven may have mercy upon you."



### THE COAT





But Jamal would never admit that he was wrong. He would say:


"It's not my fault. I haven't done anything wrong. They made me angry, which made me behave like that."




Murtaza laughed. "If you win, you can have the jacket," he said.



"It is a charity to give directions to someone who is searching for a place."





The second woman's son started to sing one of his mother's favorite songs.


All the women applicated him.


The third woman's son came and asked: "Shall I help you, Mom?" and picked up the basket.


The women stopped the old man and asked him what he thought of their talented children.

"I advise everyone to serve their mother."









When Sara heard what Aisha was saying she ran to the neighbor's house. But they were too late; the poor man had just died.






The other boy's father had died a few years ago. He lived with his mother and two little sisters and they had just moved to the neighborhood. Ammaar shared his lunch with him that day.




Ali felt sad and ashamed. He had wished for a car, but there were many people living in the same city who didn't have enough money for food or didn't have a proper house to sleep in.
